Step 2: Connect +12volt positive lead to any +12 volt power source available in vehicle.

Connect - Ground negative lead to any Ground source available in vehicle.

Step 1: Search for "**vMEyeSuper**" ^{Less} in your App Store/Play Store and install it for free.

Step 2: -Open settings in your phone -Select "Wi-Fi"

Step 3: Select camera's Wi-Fi (default Wi-Fi name: MASTER)Password: 12345678.



Step 5: Input cameras info: (Default IP Address: <u>192.168.16.101)</u> Port: <u>34567</u> User ID: <u>admin</u> Password: no password (<u>leave blank!</u>)

Click "**Save**" and the camera will be added to "Device List" See (**Fig 1.1**) on the next page.

Step 6: (ONLY REQUIRED IF YOU HAVE MORE THAN 1 CAMERA)

Follow **Step 5** and simply add each camera with its own unique IP Address. Keep in mind you should have as many added devices as you do cameras when you are finished. In your phones Wi-Fi settings, make sure you're connected to the "MASTER" Wi-Fi in order to view all the other cameras. Then click each "+" icon in each of the 4 squares on the main page and select each camera to their own square. See (Fig 1.2) on the next page for reference.
